


Progress updates increase survey completion rates

Surveys give people an opportunity to be heard and provide government with **vital information about the impact of its services.**

Data Exchange is a new reporting platform for capturing meaningful information about service delivery outcomes achieved by grant receiving organisations. As part of this platform, a client survey was piloted to **enable clients to self-report** on the outcomes of accessing these services.

BETA partnered with the Department of Social Services to develop and test ways to encourage greater survey completion rates.



We inserted five progress updates into the survey. These pages contained a behaviourally informed message accompanied by a graphic.



Recieving these progress updates increased **survey completion by 6.8 percentage points,** from 84.7 per cent to 91.5 per cent.
