



# Prompting accuracy: Using behavioural insights to support accurate registrations

By registering on the Personal Property Securities Register (PPSR), businesses can safeguard their security interests. But these registrations must be accurate - even a small mistake can render a registration invalid.



We partnered with AFSA to evaluate two changes to the PPSR form that could reduce these mistakes.

## New Review Screen



To prevent users from rushing through the registration, and to highlight the importance of registering correctly, we added a pop-up at the final review screen, and required users to confirm the details they inputted.



The new review screen **did not affect accuracy.**

## New Layout & Prompts



To prevent users from making mistakes, we presented questions in a more straightforward way and added five prompts that appeared if a common mistake was made.



These changes **almost halved the number of incorrect transactions.**



We halved the error rate by asking questions in a more straightforward way and adding prompts. These changes helped PPSR users identify and correct their mistakes.
